



Weybourne Wander

From The Maltings, turn left and follow the road until you reach the next left onto Beach Lane. Continue along Beach Lane all the way to the coast, where you'll turn left again to walk along the shoreline on the Peddar's Way and Norfolk Coast Path. Keep following this path until you arrive at a stretch of beach known as Kelling Hard. Here, take another left and follow the path as it bends around to the right past The Quag. After passing the lake, you'll come to a fork in the path - keep left, which will lead you to the main road, Weybourne Road. Stay on this road for a short distance until you see a path on your right that leads down to Kelling Heath. Follow this path until it meets Holgate Hill, where you'll turn left. Continue along this road as it becomes Holt Road, which will bring you back into Weybourne village and onto The Street. Turn left here to return to The Maltings.

Around & About

Just a short stroll from The Maltings, guests can explore two of Weybourne's most charming attractions. Weybourne Station, a beautifully restored Edwardian stop on the North Norfolk Railway (the Poppy Line), offers a step back in time with its original architecture, vintage signals, bookshop, model railway, and even a replica WWII allotment overlooking the countryside.

A little further on, the Muckleburgh Military Collection, set on a former WWII anti-aircraft training camp, is the UK's largest privately owned military museum, featuring over 150 historic military vehicles, tanks, and aircraft, many of which are still operational. Both sites are ideal for a relaxed day out on foot, offering rich insights into the area's heritage.
